Abstract: The Hartford Audubon Society records document the activities

of the Hartford Audubon Society (HAS), formerly known as the Hartford Bird Study Club. The records are a mix of physical materials, held at the Wood Memorial Library in South Windsor,

and digital materials held in cloud storage by HAS.

Biographical / Historical

Hartford area residents founded the Hartford Bird Study Club on May 18, 1909, after recognizing that there was a widespread local interest in birds.

From its beginnings, the Hartford Bird Study Club was active in field ornithology. Members began hosting guided walks in 1911 and kept meticulous records of bird sightings, some of which they published in scientific journals. The club first participated in the Christmas Bird Count in 1909.

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The Club also began hosting lectures on birds and conservation in 1909.

Club members started bird banding in the 1920s. Frederick T. Bashour and E. Alexander Bergstrom led a large-scale bird banding program in the 1940s-1960s.

In 1949, the Hartford Bird Study Club incorporated as a non-profit, tax-exempt organization. This enabled it to accept donations of land for wildlife sanctuaries and grow its endowment.

In 1965, the Club changed its name to the Hartford Audubon Society, Inc.

Today, the Hartford Audubon Society (HAS) continues to contribute to conservation, education, and research. HAS manages four wildlife sanctuaries: Station 43 (South Windsor; a Special Focus Area of the Silvio Conte NFWR), Greenstone Hollow (East Granby), Lewis Farm (Suffield), and Tobacco Valley (Windsor). In addition, it provides financial support for bird conservation, education, and research in Connecticut, such as through its Mini Grants program, and participates in state-level conservation dialogue. HAS continues to hold guided trips, both locally and throughout the Northeast; as of 2023, it has held over 3,300. It also continues to host speakers at its monthly meetings. HAS maintains its founders' friendly spirit of competition through a variety of bird counts and competitions, which likewise support research and conservation. HAS publishes a quarterly newsletter, The Crest.

Scope and Contents

The Hartford Audubon Society records document the activities of the Hartford Audubon Society (HAS), formerly known as the Hartford Bird Study Club. The records consist of administrative records and reports, financial records, minutes, land and preserve records, program records, newsletters and pamphlets, education and conservation records, field notes, historical sketches, information technology records, photographs, and ephemera.

The records are a mix of physical materials, held at the Wood Memorial Library in South Windsor, and digital materials held in cloud storage by HAS.

Series 1. Administrative records (1909-2023) consists of board of director records, officer records, annual reports, membership records, organizational documents, legal records, policies and procedures, and administrative correspondence.

Series 2. Financial records (1925-2023) includes accounting records, financial documents, and Finance Committee minutes.

Series 3. Member meetings (1909-2023) includes member meeting minutes (1909-2023), information about the annual meeting and banquet (e.g., planning materials, annual awards), and minutes from the study group (2022).

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- Series 4. Preserves (1950-2023) contains information about current and former HAS preserves.
- Series 5. Programs (1911-2023) contains annual program booklets (1911-2023), other program information, Programs Committee records, and trip reports.
- Series 6. Publications (1902-2023) includes publications issued by HAS, including checklists of Hartford County birds (1929, 1954) and the Crest newsletter (1958-2023). It also includes a 1902 publication by John H. Sage, a club member.
- Series 7. Conservation, research, and education (1981-2023) documents HAS' support of conservation, research, and education in Connecticut, including through partnerships, donations, and the Mini Grants program.
- Series 8. Bird counts and competitions (1934-2023) contains records of HAS' various bird counts and competitions, including the Christmas Bird Count, Summer Bird Count, Spring Census, Big January, Daylight Savings Bird-a-thon, and the Big Sit.
- Series 9. Field notes (1909-1997) includes historical field notes from HAS members. These include the Book of the Immortals, a ledger outlining club members' year lists of birds from 1909-1934; the "Record of all species actually seen in the Hartford region within 20 miles of Old State House," a card file describing notable bird sightings in Hartford County, including significant unpublished records, from the nineteenth century through 1996; and the field journals of Albert Morgan (1910-1911, 1929-1944), Walter Charsky (1926-1997), and Elliot Dodge (1948-1951).
- Series 10. Organizational history (1909-2022) contains historical information about HAS and HAS members.
- Series 11. Information technology (2001-2023) includes documentation for technologies that HAS uses, as well as IT Committee minutes.
- Series 12. Photographs (1925-2023) includes photographs taken by HAS members.
- Series 13. Artifacts and ephemera (1916-2022) contains HAS ephemera.
- Series 14. Book and archival collections information (1953-2023) includes information about the HAS library and archival collections, both of which are currently housed at the Wood Memorial Library.

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George T. Griswold, one of the Hartford Bird Study Club's most active early members, donated his field notes (1911-1954) to the University of Connecticut. They can be found in the Biodiversity Research Collections (BRC) Library: https://biodiversity.uconn.edu/. Griswold's field notes elaborate on some of the sightings described in the HAS field notes.

Eugene W. Schmidt, another early leader of the Hartford Bird Study Club, donated his collection of bird specimens to the New Britain Institute in 1915. Schmidt's specimens, which corroborate some of the field notes in this collection, are now held by the New Britain Youth Museum: https://www.newbritainyouthmuseum.org/.
