Abstract: The Erastus W. Burnham collection documents the life of

Erastus W. Burnham of South Windsor. It contains Burnham's correspondence, including letters from aboard a whaling boat near New Zealand (1851-1852), 77 Civil War letters (1862-1865), and letters from Burnham's inlaws in Glasgow, Scotland (1855-1870). It also contains Civil War and veterans

association ephemera, a collection of about 500 Native

American artifacts from South Windsor, and biographical and

genealogical material.

Biographical / Historical

Erastus W. Burnham was born on April 28, 1834, in South Windsor, Connecticut.

In 1851, at age 17, Burnham departed New London, CT, aboard the Hannibal, a whaling boat, which sailed around the Cape of Good Hope to Australia, then New Zealand and the Pacific Islands. The crew then sailed to the Arctic, whaling near the Bering Strait. In 1852,

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they returned to Hong Kong, where Burnham deserted the voyage and became a policeman. Burnham resigned from the Hong Kong police on July 1, 1853, and returned to the U.S. by way of St. Helena and the Azores.

Upon returning to the U.S., Burnham worked in a paper mill in Holyoke, MA.

Burnham enlisted in the Civil War as a Union volunteer on December 28, 1861. He served in the Twelfth Connecticut Infantry Regiment, participating in the capture of New Orleans in 1862. Burnham reenlisted on January 5, 1864, and served through the war's conclusion in the First Connecticut Heavy Artillery Regiment. He mustered out in September 1865.

Following the war, Burnham returned to South Windsor, where he operated a tobacco farm and lived for the remainder of his life, passing away on April 11, 1921.

Scope and Contents

The Erastus W. Burnham collection documents the life of Erastus W. Burnham of South Windsor. It contains Burnham's correspondence and collections of ephemera and Native American artifacts; and biographical and genealogical material assembled by Burnham's descendents and Wood Memorial staff.

Series 1. Correspondence (1851-1916) includes Erastus W. Burnham's correspondence, including four letters from while Burnham was on a whaling boat near New Zealand (1851-1852), letters from Burnham to his wife Mary soon after he returned from Hong Kong (1857-1858), 77 Civil War letters (1862-1865), letters from Burnham's inlaws in Glasgow, Scotland (1855-1870), and letters concerning a Hartford Courant article about Burnham's life (1916).

Series 2. Civil War records (1864-1865) contains documents from Burnham's Civil War service, including a list of disabilities that he received and passes to travel from camp in 1865.

Series 3. Objects and ephemera (1862-1912) includes Civil War ephemera, such as battlefield relics and Confederate bills; veterans association ephemera; ephemera from South Windsor, such as a penmanship practice book from Burnham's adolescence; and a collection about 500 Native American artifacts from South Windsor.

Series 4. Burnham family (2004-2010) includes biographical information about E. W. Burnham and genealogical information about the Burnham family, including oral histories recorded when descendants Elizabeth Burnham Bennett and Edwin Burnham donated the collection.

Series 5. Collection information (2004-2008) includes information about this archival collection.

The collection is arranged in five series: Series 1. Correspondence; Series 2. Civil War records, Series 3. Objects and ephemera; Series 4. Burnham family; and Series. 5. Collection information.
